Former Greater Pittsburgh International Airport Terminal

The old terminal would sit empty - with the exception of some offices - for the next five years. Demolition of the old terminal began in 1997 - only to be halted for asbestos removal. During that time period, numerous proposals and ideas would be floated to develop the old terminal and the land around it. Proposals from building new sports stadiums, preserving it for a transportation museum, an indoor NASCAR track, along with other ideas.

After the asbestos abatement was completed, the demolition of the old terminal would resume in 1999. Eventually, the old terminal would be demolished and redeveloped as a business park.
