## **HEINLEIN GENEALOGY**

## Johann Michael Heinlein (1832 to 1912) Agnes Heffman Heinlein

Michael's wife, Agnetis Heinlein, died 18 April 1906 in Hopewell Township, at the age of 70 years and 10 months (Document 3). Elizabeth Heinlein of 14 Kuhn Street filled out Agnetis's death certificate, stating that Agnetis was born in Beergeweisaele[?], Oberfranken, Bavaria, the daughter of "Micheal" Hoffman and "Margret" B. Pickel. Her place of birth is probably Burgweisach, which is close to Schornweisach, her husband's birthplace.

Recall that only three children accompanied their parents to America in 1889, but we have already identified four, including Sabina. Agnes reportedly had given birth to 4 children, with only 3 still alive in 1900, according to her enumeration in Stowe in 1900. Her enumeration in Elliott, however, stated that she had borne 7 children, with 6 still alive. Apparently, the larger number of children was more correct, as we discovered another daughter during our research.
