The earliest church books for Schornweisach were burned, so the first one available begins in 1827. The researcher was able to make copies of the baptisms of the youngest children, and extracts of those entries are given in the accompanying research journal. Since Bernhard Heinlein and Margaretha Elisabetha Kolb married in 1822, a copy of their marriage will not be obtainable.

Bernhard's father, Heinrich Heinlein, was from Reinhardshofen, which is 5.6 kilometers due south of Schornweisach, so further research on the Heinlein family should hopefully be possible by searching those records.
