July 31-- August 2	Weekend excursions to Venice and Royal Bavarian Castles. Time and place of departure will be announced well in advance.

August 25	Each tour will conclude in Munich. Check in time at the Munich Airport is 1:30 P.M., August 25, 1970. <u>Independent travelers are responsible to meet the aircraft on time.</u> Those in Salzburg will be brought to the airport direct by bus with the Academy advisor in charge. Luggage stored in Salzburg will also be brought to the air port by bus. Departure from Europe at Munich is at 3:20 P.M. (local time). Arrival in Cleveland Hopkins International Airport at 9:30 P.M. August 25th. The program officially ends upon landing in Cleveland.
