1st Day NEW YORK Departure this evening from J.F. Kennedy Airport on your flight to Zurich. Dinner and breakfast will be served aboard. Flight time: approx. 7 hours.

2nd Day ZUR/LUC Arrival this morning at the Zurich Airport where your private motorcoach will be waiting to drive you to Lovely Lucerne. Transfer to your hotel with the remainder of the day to get acquainted with this lovely city.

3rd Day LUCERNE A colorful sightseeing tour will include the Lion Monument, Chapel Bridge, Glacier Garden, Hofkirche, the Musegg Towers and Weinmarket Fountain. The afternoon will be at your leisure for shopping or on an optional basis, an excursion to Mt. Pilatus will be available. Evening free for own entertainment.

4th Day LUC/INNS Leave Lucerne for Vaduz, Liechtenstein, one of the smallest independent states in Europe; a land of lush green with the reigning Monarch's castle the main tourist attraction. Continue your drive by crossing the border into Austria to Innsbruck, Capitol of the Tyrol and one of the most beautiful towns in the whole world. Transfer to your hotel with the remainder of the day free.

5th Day

INNS/SALZ

A sightseeing tour of the city showing you the Golden Roof, Tiroler Volkskunst Museum with its colorful collection of Tyrolean costumes, the University, the Hofburg and Olympic Village, site of the 1976 Winter Olympics. In the afternoon board your motorcoach and travel to Salzburg, home of Mozart. Upon arrival you will be taken to your hotel and afterwards the rest of the day is yours for own interests.

6th Day SALZBURG This morning you will enjoy a sightseeing tour including Mozart's House, Salzburg Cathedral - lovely Renaissance building, Abbey of St. Peter with some early Christian catacombs, and Mirabell Castle - exquisite smaller edition of the Tuileries. The afternoon is at leisure for shopping in the almost irrestible shops specializing in Tyrolean costumes or for own activities.

Today you depart from this loevely Austrian city and travel via Lake Chiemsee with a stop for a boat trip on the Lake to see the famous castle which is an imitation of the Versailles. Then through the Bavarian Alps to Munich and your hotel.
