## FINAL ITINERARY

- JUNE 25 Depart Toronto International Airport at 1:20 A. M. June 25, 1968 (local time). Check in at the General Aviation Counter no later than 11:20 P. M. June 24, 1968.
- Arrival in Munich, West Germany at 3:30 P. M. (Note: we lose a night's sleep because of the time difference: Flight time about 7 1/2 hours.
- Motor coaches will pick us up at 3:30 P. M. and we will go via Autobahn to Salzburg. Arrival in Salzburg about 6:00 P. M. The Austrian host families will meet us and take us home for supper.
- JUNE 26 Families will either escort you or give you very explicit directions to the Harrer Stuberl for lunch at 12:00 noon. After the meal Dr. Walter Seidlhofer, Director of the Internationale Ferienkurse will give a short welcome address and introduce the professors.
- JUNE 27 Placement test for all those who have had prior German at 2:00 - 3:00 P. M. at the dining hall.
- JUNE 28 Day trip to Werfen and Lichtensteinklamm.
- JUNE 29 Free day to see city with advisors who will show you where classes will be held, etc.
- JUNE 30 Day trip to Chiemsee
