

## MITTELFRANKEN (Middle Franconia) / BAVARIA / GERMANY

**Middle Franconia** (German: *Mittelfranken*, pronounced [ˈmɪtl̩ˌfr̩ʌŋkn̩] (listen)) is one of the three administrative regions of Franconia in Bavaria, Germany.<sup>[2]</sup> It is located in the west of Bavaria and borders the state of Baden-Württemberg. The administrative seat is Ansbach; however, the most populous city is Nuremberg.

The region is divided into seven districts ('Landkreise') and five independent cities ('Kreisfreie Städte').<sup>[4]</sup>

### Economy

The Gross domestic product (GDP) of the region was 78.6 billion € in 2018, accounting for 2.4% of German economic output. GDP per capita adjusted for purchasing power was 40,900 € or 136% of the EU27 average in the same year. The GDP per employee was 105% of the EU average.
