Harry Heinlein (stepson)

Harry was born 29 July 1886 in West End, Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania (Document 17). He was the son of Christina Teepe, but his biological father has yet to be identified. It's possible Harry's father is Christina Teepe's first husband, who had the surname Hagenberg but no record has been found that connects the two. Birth records in the area exist for this time period, but nothing was located that match Harry, even though one was found for his half-sister, Wilhelmine.

With a bit more time, searching the previous index (the one where the Teese boy was found) for Harrys with any surname born in 1886 may reveal who his birth father was. Alternatively, using DNA by testing his descendants may be the only way to identify the birth father.
