

Harry's World War I draft registration records that he had a wife and four children. Harry died at the age of 36 in a tractor accident, on 15 June 1922 (Document 18). Interestingly, his death certificate states that Konrad Heinlein is his father, which, when considering he took the surname Heinlein as his own, makes sense. He is buried in Green Tree Cemetery.
