We identified most of John Heinlein's descendants to living people, though there may be a little more we can do to locate information about one of his daughters, Ruth W. Heinlein.

John Conrad Heinlein (1867–1958)

Johann Conrad Heinlein was born on 21 July 1867 in Münchsteinach, Bavaria, Germany. The earliest record of him in the U.S. is his 4 November 1890 marriage to Bertha A. Charlton in Allegheny County, Pennsylvania (Document 2). The marriage record gives John's birthday as 21 July 1868 and his occupation as a farmer. William C. Charlton was present at the ceremony and gave written permission for his daughter to marry.

John and Bertha had four children, William John, Mary Isabella, Alice Florence, and Ruth W. In the 1900 census, John, Bertha, and their three oldest children were living together in Moon, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania (Document 4). John, a naturalized farmer, rented his home. By 1910, the family owned their own home, and added to their children was their youngest daughter, Ruth, born in 1906 (Document 5). Their farm was specified as a "truck farm" meaning that they were growing vegetables for market.
