

HEINLEIN GENEALOGY

JOHN CONRAD HEINLEIN (1868 TO 1958)

John Heinlein owned a dairy farm in Moon in 1920 (Document 7). Even though the 1900 census states that John was naturalized, this enumeration claims he was still an alien. Along with his wife, Bertha, only their daughters Mary and Ruth remained at home. Ruth's age appears to be a mistake, since she should have been about 14 at the time, but the census shows she was only 11 years old.

The 1930 census reports that 64-year-old John had retired (Document 6). He and Bertha rented their home on Cliff Mine Road and were living alone. In 1940, John and Bertha still lived in Moon, and their 44-year-old daughter Alice Betlyn, who was divorced, was back living with them (Document 8). John had completed the fourth grade in school and his wife had completed the third grade, while their daughter completed the seventh grade.

Conclusion

Most of the descendants of John C. Heinlein and his wife, Bertha A. Charlton, were identified during this session, although there may be more that can be done to learn additional details about Ruth W. Heinlein's children. Many recent records are unavailable due to privacy restrictions, however.
