HEINLEIN GENEALOGY

John Heinlein, father (1836 to 1919)

As you already know, Abtsgreuth is a village in the parish of Münchsteinach, and Johann Heinlein was living there when he married in 1865. It's possible that the births of his children actually occurred in Abtsgreuth, and they were baptized in Münchsteinch. We would have to examine the original records to tell for sure. The notation on Johann Michael's baptism that he was the fifth child born to this couple (or at least to this mother) indicates that there probably was a child born before Johann's and Margaretha's marriage in 1865, possibly in her home parish of Gleissenberg. We would need to search those registers, which are housed in an archives in Nürnburg, to see if we could identify that child. Perhaps it is the Johann Georg Heinlein mentioned in the 1883 list of emigrants above.

We were sent a copy of Johann Heinlein's baptism from the Protestant Parish in Schornweisach, Bavaria, showing that he was born 10 April 1836 at about 1:00 p.m. and was baptized on 15 April (Document 2). He was the seventh child of Bernhard (not Leonhard) Heinlein, a farmer, and his wife, Margaretha Elisabeth Kolb. Apparently, the parish had misread Johann's father's name, since a capital "B" in the old German script looks like an "L."

Clearly, the best way to get more information on Johann Heinlein's family would be to visit the parish of Schornweisach in person, to search the original registers. A family book, compiled from the original baptisms and marriages, had been created, showing the following family (Document 3):
