

HEINLEIN GENEALOGY

John Heinlein, father (1836 to 1919)



The German researcher sent me his results. He found the following family in the Schornweisach records:

Bernhard Heinlein, farmer in Sch.; son of Heinr. Heinlein, farmer in Reinhardshof[en]; married 2nd Easter [8 April] 1822 with

~~Marg~~ Elis. Kolb, born 15 February 1804, daughter of Joh. George Kolb, farmer in Sch., and Magdal. Helena Lippold in Sch.

Children:

- 1) Joh. Georg, born 5 April 1823
- 2) Elisab., born 27 November 1824; died 7 December 1835
- 3) Joh. Georg, born 12 October 1827; died 1 May 1829
- 4) Elisab. Barb., born 3 June 1829; died 21 January 1831
- 5) Joh. Michael, born 25 February 1832
- 6) Elisab. Barbara, born 24 May 1834
- 7) Johann, born 10 April 1836

Originally, the father of Johann was thought to be Leonard, but the person reading the record made a mistake; it was actually Bernhard, which fits more with the "Binkort" given in John's 1919 death record as his father. As you can see, there was no brother named Johann Conrad born in 1827, so the man by that name who lived in PA is not part of this family. Neither was there a brother named George born about 1840, at least not in the "family book" that was compiled by the minister from the original church registers.
