Michael Johann Heinlein

Michael was born on 6 October 1895 in Coraopolis, Pennsylvania, and died 9 August 1975. He and his wife, Wilhelmina “Minnie” Sophia Ehle, had children named Herbert, Mildred, and Harold.

Mildred Elise Heinlein

The obituary for Mildred states that she was a member of the First Baptist Church and a “beloved sister” to her two brothers (Document 17). She was born 1 October 1916 and died 26 January 1999. She bore no children.

Herbert Henry Heinlein

Mildred’s twin, Herbert, or “Herb” as he was most commonly known, had a close connection to golfing. He, his father, and his brother started building Bon Air Golf Course, now Moon Golf Club, in 1933 “using only a donkey and a shovel” (Document 19). In 1964, Herb built Ponderosa Golf Course with his brother and he became sole owner in 1979. Aside from golf, Herb also served in the Navy and earned the Point System Medal, WWII Victory Medal, and American Campaign Theater Ribbon. Together with his wife, Thelma Rose “Mick” Smith, Herb had two children: Michael Herbert Heinlein and Janet M. Heinlein.

Harold D. Heinlein

Michael’s youngest son, Harold, was born on 28 April 1919 and married Margaret “Mush” Mushalansky. The couple had three children together: Ellen, James Michael, and Harold Donald, Jr. Harold died 27 May 2012 and was a member of Zion Lutheran Church. His obituary mentions seven grandchildren and three great-grandchildren, but research was not able to determine their names or which of his children they belong to.
