graduated from Coraopolis High School
in 1948. He began his college education
at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh,
and graduated from Ohio Northern
University School of Pharmacy in 1952.
He served in the U.S. Army as a
pharmacy technician in Germany until
1954. After serving, he entered graduate
school at the University of Pittsburgh.
During this time he met and married
Eileen Anne Sullivan in 1959. Following
graduation, he joined the faculty of
Oregon State University School of

Pharmacy in 1965. Rich joined the Kaiser
Permanente Center for Health Research
as a full-time investigator in 1973, where
he published more than 70 articles as well
as partnered in the development of
Kaisers drug formulary and an automated
refill pharmacy program. He retired in
1997. Rich enjoyed cross-country skiing,
beachcombing, international travel and
maintaining an impressive collection of
model trains. He is survived by his wife
of 57 years, Eileen; daughter, Kelly Streit
(Russell); sons, Jay (Deborah), Brian
(Carol) and Joel (Dusty); and seven
