Paul sent me this update on the farm research today:

I already heard back from the researcher, who went to the courthouse today:

"I have searched the Deeds for properties purchased by John/Johan and his four sons beginning with a purchase by John in 1884 and ending in 1965 when Michael (the last surviving son) passed away.

There are 58 property transfers TO the Heinleins in that period, mostly in Moon and Coraopolis.

It would require checking every Deed to get an address and then checking deed transfers FROM the Heinleins to see a date of sale for each property."

Dear Ed:

We have finished our examination of the Heinlein deeds filed in Allegheny County. Extracts of the deeds copied are given in the accompanying research journal, in chronological order, and the original deeds have also been provided, so you can get more detailed information from them. As you will see, most of the tracts of land are identified by pins, posts, stones, etc. that were geographic markers at that time, with the occasional road mentioned, as well as property owners whose land adjoined each tract. Therefore, trying to plot these on plat maps would be difficult.

We have obtained the most important deeds involving Heinlein family members, not every single one filed, as that would have entailed much more research and copying of records. If there is something else you would like done concerning this phase of research, please let Brian Smith know. Thank you for your continued business.
