  - Frank Krentz (2/1870 to 1/4/1947)
    - a. born in Stolberg, Westphalia (Germany today) in 1870
    - b. came to America in 1890 and was a glass worker
    - c. died in 1947 at age of 77
    - d. Frank's family: brother, Peter Kreutz (Krentz) of Ford City, Pa; 4 sisters, Mrs. Paul Einsporo; Mrs. Sebastian Weber of Butler; Mrs. Christina Kamer of Ford City; and Mrs. Matthew Lux of Ford City
  - Caroline "Carrie" Josephine Heymann Krentz (3/1880 to 12/9/1963)
    - a. born in Stolberg, Westphalia (Germany today) in 1880
    - b. came to America in 1890
    - c. died in 1963 at age of 83
    - d. Carrie was 10 years younger than her husband and had first child at age 24
    - e. Ed Jr remembers visiting her on Christmas Eve at the house on Maple Street as a child each year
  - Granny's mother and father are buried in the cemetery at the Catholic Church off
     Thorn Run Road in Moon Township, lower entrance on the road to Mooncrest
